

HOME SCHOOL RESEARCH PRESENTATION INSTRUCTIONS to the Students

(Teacher Note: These are the instructions provided to the students)

As the final part of your Young Scholars Program experience, you are to present your research project to at least one class or appropriate gathering when you return to your home school. The choice of class or gathering is up to you in consultation with your nominating teacher and other science teachers at your school. A good audience might be students who are in Biology, AP Biology, or Chemistry class.

When you give your presentation, remember to talk about how you got interested in research, what the experience was like, and how it has affected your views of science and scientific research in addition to presenting the actual project and your findings. Be sure to use visual aids when making the presentation to insure a clear understanding by your audience. Remember, you have become an expert on your topic and you have been surrounded by others who have shared your experience. The students at your school might not be quite as ready for the highly technical nature of your work.

To verify the completion of your home school presentation, please submit a short video (2 minutes minimum) to Canvas (<http://canvas.ucdavis.edu>). The video can be taken with your cell phone, tablet, or recording device of your choice. It should show you presenting the introduction of your project. Your video should include your name and some evidence of the date to verify when it was done. The video does not need to include any other students. It will only be used for assessment and verification purposes only.

After you have given your presentation, your nominating teacher will complete the online Teacher Evaluation Form (URL listed below). If I have received this completed form by October 10th, I will send a copy of your grades to the registrar at UC Davis. Until that time, your transcript will indicate no grade (NG).

It is **IMPORTANT** to complete the presentation by early October so that the feedback information reaches me by October 10th. If you stick to this time line, your transcripts should be available in time for early college application deadlines near the first of November. **Transcripts can be requested at <http://registrar.ucdavis.edu>**
